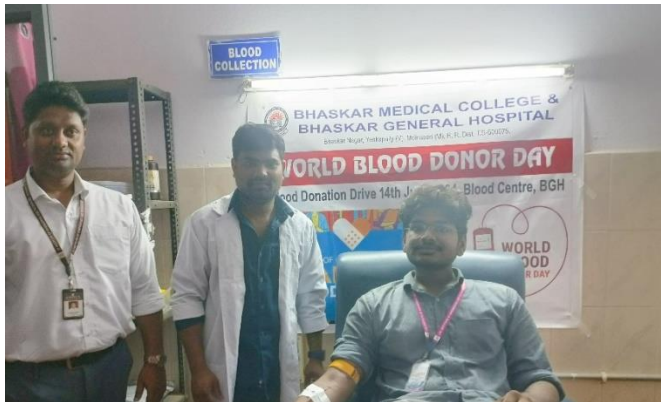


Introduction
